THURSDAY, DECEMBER 4

Professor Jamie Raskin, professor of constitutional law at American University's Washington College of Law and a progressive Democratic State Senator in Maryland, will speak on the Supreme Court's interpretations of "persons" in the Citizens United and Hobby Lobby decisions. A magna cum laude graduate of Harvard College and a graduate of Harvard Law School, where he was an editor of The Harvard Law Review, Professor Raskin has written dozens of essays and law review articles and several books, including Overruling Democracy: The Supreme Court versus the American People, an analysis of conservative judicial activism, and We the Students: Supreme Court Cases For and About Students. He co-founded the Marshall-Brennan Constitutional Literacy Project which has sent hundreds of law students from seven different law schools into public high schools to teach thousands of students in courses on constitutional literacy. He has also been an active pro bono lawyer in cases involving free speech, Greenpeace, censorship, and other civil rights issues.

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 11

Sherman Fleek, U.S. army lieutenant colonel and currently command historian for the United States Military Academy at West Point, will speak on the Battle of the Bulge, with an emphasis on the role of air power in the battle. Col. Fleek has written numerous articles on military, frontier army, Mexican War and Civil War history, and in 2006 published his first book, the award-winning History May Be Searched in Vain: A Military History of the Mormon Battalion. He holds a MA in American History from the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs. The Battle began almost 70 years ago on December 16, 1944 at 5:30AM with an artillery eruption along the 85-mile Ghost Front in the Ardennes area of eastern Belgium and northern Luxembourg. An hour later, 250,000 German troops began to advance west against a surprised 70,000, primarily American, troops who defended the sector. The battle lasted about six weeks and was the largest battle the Americans fought in WWII. Approximately 90,000 Americans died. The Germans were counting on the thick fog and overcast skies that prevailed at the time to blunt American superiority in the skies.
