## FREE TAX PREP AND E-FILING FEDERAL & STATE

The IRS/AARP provides a tax preparation service at no charge in Westport during the February to mid-April tax season. A number of Y's Men have used this service for several years, and a few have been volunteer counselors. It's open to all individual filers regardless of age or income level, with emphasis on low- and middle-income households, and those ages 60 and older. This year, in response to demand, this service has been expanded and will be available at the *Westport Center for Senior Activities* on Wednesdays and Thursdays (Appointments: 203-341-5099), and at *Westport Town Hall* on Mondays (Appointments: 203-341-1050).

## MENTORS NEEDED

**Connect** with refugee families arriving in Bridgeport. Refugees have been uprooted from their homes and displaced due to war and violence. They may be unfamiliar with basic tasks such as grocery shopping, riding public transportation and dressing for the weather. They may be in need of a conversation partner or simply a friendly face to help them integrate into their new community. Become a mentor with the *International Institute of Connecticut*. All that is asked is one hour once a week for three months. 
## GOLF
