Dan Libertino and **John Bulakowski** will discuss the three aviation careers of Igor Sikorsky and the Sikorsky company starting with the Russian Years 1889-1918, Early American Years 1919-1938, and the helicopter period 1939-to his death in 1972, along with limited current company activities.
