THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3

Y's Man Peter Kolbrener, a member of the Westport Commission for Senior Services, will moderate a panel discussion of the many helpful and useful services the town provides for its seniors. Panel members are Susan Pfister, director of the Westport Center for Senior Activities, Holly Betts, the Center's program manager, Sarah Heath, director of the Westport Department of Human Services, and Kristen Witt, a social worker for the Department and the town's Municipal Agent for the Elderly. Ample time will be allowed for audience questions. Prior to the panel, Marc Hartog, deputy director of the Westport Emergency Medical Service will discuss the services his organization provides. Over the past year, WEMS has responded to more than 2,500 calls for medical assistance.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 10

Y's Men will get an inside look at the Fairfield County dining scene in a panel discussion with Chef Matt Storch of Match Restaurant, South Norwalk, and Stephanie Webster, editor in chief and founder of CT Bites, an online guide to great food in Fairfield County. Chef Storch took the helm at Match in 2000 and introduced culinary innovation and a unique twist on the classics. Stephanie has a restaurant background but following a career outside the field, she relocated back to CT and made it her quest to find great food, and support a community of eaters that live for their next meal.

Barbara Pearson-Rac is a woman of many talents. Known locally for chairing Westport's Make A Difference Day, Board President of First Night, and the wife of Y's Man Frank Rac, she has been an adjunct criminology professor at the University of Massachusetts, coordinator of a national cancer research project at Harvard and corporate IT executive at Colgate-Palmolive, and more. Her first novel, *On Track*, introduced four main characters, who just happen to be seniors that spearheaded her into her second novel *All Ears*. A third book, *Break Even*, is ready to explode from her imaginative brain! She will discuss the craft of the mystery writer.
