FREE TAX RETURNS

The IRS/AARP will be providing a no charge, tax preparation and filing service in Westport during the January 30, 2017 through April 18, 2017 season. Numerous Y's Men have used this service for several years, and a few have been volunteer counselors. Last season over 730 returns were prepared and filed in Westport, almost all electronically. Refunds totaling \$870,000 were received by Westport clients, about a third of which being from tax credits such as for education and earned income. It's open to all individual filers regardless of age or income level, with emphasis on low and middle income households, and those ages 60 and older. The service will be available at the Westport Center for Senior Activities on Wednesdays (9:00-4:00) and Thursdays (1:00-8:00) by making an appointment at 203-341-5099; and at Westport Town Hall (1:00-7:00) via appointment at 203-341-1050.
